

## NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS AND INSTALLERS REGARDING INSTALLATION

## HOW TO AVOID POTENTIAL DOOR AND DRAWER ALIGNMENT ISSUES WHEN INSTALLING ABODIAN PRODUCTS

You've made a significant and long term investment in your Abodian cabinetry; when installed properly, there is plenty of adjustment in the system to align doors, drawers and panels to maintain consistent gaps. With modest attention to detail and reasonable accommodation of typical installation environment anomalies, you should enjoy plenty of adjustability in the finished surfaces of your cabinets.

Abodian products are designed and built with the highest quality materials incorporating construction standards with tolerances of 3/1000 of an inch or less. Our hardware is the best available and has adjustability far exceeding Abodian manufacturing tolerances.

Nearly ALL installation environments are not this exacting. Consequently, the potential for misalignment of doors and drawers exists if the installer is not careful to install Abodian products plumb, true, tight and square.

The unique Abodian construction method (dowel and confirmat) along with the stout materials used creates a cabinet box that is extraordinarily rigid. This condition puts extra demands on the installer to ensure that every cabinet box is installed plumb, true and square and tight to the adjacent cabinet by shimming and correcting for discrepancies in the installation environment.

Cabinets that are installed without deliberate and focused attention to alignment can lose their adjustability.

PLEASE ENSURE THE INSTALLATION ACCOMODATES OUT OF PLUMB, NON-FLAT, NON-SQUARE WALLS AND UNLEVEL FLOORS. THIS IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INSTALLER.
